

**THE BARBIL MUNICIPAL COUNCIL (POSTPONEMENT
OF ELECTION) ORDINANCE, 1979**

[Promulgated by the Governor on the 31st January 1979, published
in an Extraordinary issue of the Orissa Gazette, dated the
31st January 1979]

AN

ORDINANCE

TO PROVIDE FOR THE POSTPONEMENT OF ELECTION
TO THE BARBIL MUNICIPAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS the Legislature of the State of Orissa is not in session;

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Orissa is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action to provide for the postponement of election to the Barbil Municipal Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 213 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance in the Thirtieth Year of the Republic of India:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Barbil Municipal Council (Postponement of Election) Ordinance, 1979.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Orissa Municipal Councils (Postponement of Elections) Ordinance, 1978, the proceedings for holding the election for reconstitution of the Municipal Council of Barbil Municipality in the district of Keonjhar as constituted under the Orissa Municipal Act, 1950, which has been stayed by the State Government in exercise of the powers conferred on them under sub-rule (2) of rule 60 of the Orissa Municipal (Chairman and Councillors) Election Rules, 1950, shall be carried out under the provisions of the said rules from such stage as the State Government may order, so, however, that the aforesaid elections shall be completed by a date not later than the 25th day of March, 1979.
