## **ORDINANCE**

TO AMEND THE BIHAR AND ORISSA MOTOR VEHICLES TAXATION ACT, 1930 AND THE MADRAS MOTOR VEHICLES TAXATION ACT, 1931 IN THEIR APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF ORISSA

WHEREAS the Legislature of the State of Orissa is not in session;

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Orissa is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate

Bihar and action to amend the Bihar and Orissa Motor Vehicles Taxation Act, Orissa Act 1930 and the Madras Motor Vehicles Taxation Act, 1931 in their Madras Act application to the State of Orissa in the manner hereinafter 3 of 1931. appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 213 of the Constitution, the Governor is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance in the Eighteenth Year of the Republic of India-

Short title and commencement.

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Orissa Motor Vehicles Taxation Laws (Amendment) Ordinance, 1967.
- (2) This section shall come into force at once and the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from the 3rd May 1966.
- 2. In the Second Schedule to the Bihar and Orissa Motor Vehicles Bihar and Amendment of the second Taxation Act, 1930 [at the end of the entries [made under column of 1930.] (1) thereof against each of the clauses (i) to (ix) of item 3 the words Bihar and Orissa Act 2 "in weight laden" shall be added. of 1930,

3. In Schedule II to the Madras Motor Vehicles Taxation Act, Madras Act Amendment II. Madras 1931 at the end of the entires made under column (1) thereof against 3 of 1931. of Schedule each of the clauses (i) to (ix) of litem 3 the words "in weight laden" 1931. shall be added.
