

ORISSA ACT 16 OF 1989

THE ORISSA APPROPRIATION (No. 3) ACT, 1989

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Provided that in the case of Colleges and Higher Secondary Schools located in Scheduled Areas such minimum roll strength shall be half the respective minimum roll strength specified in this section.

(3) In the case of High Schools the minimum roll strength of pupils for each standard or class shall be forty which shall be twenty-five for such Schools as located in Scheduled Areas.

Explanation—The expression "Scheduled Areas" shall have the same meaning as assigned to it in Part C of the Fifth Schedule to the Constitution of India.

11-A. The prescribed authority may withhold payment of grant-in-aid to an aided educational institution, if the percentage of students passing the Annual and Supplementary examination conducted by the Board of Secondary Education or the Council of Higher Secondary Education or the concerned University, as the case may be falls short of half the percentage of students passing such examination for the same Board or Council or the University, as the case may be for three consecutive years.

10. In the principal Act in section 27, for sub-section (7), the following sub-section shall be substituted, namely:—

(7) In the principal Act and without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing powers the State Government may make rules—

(a) to regulate the establishment, recognition and management of private educational institutions being Colleges, Higher Secondary Schools, High Schools and Upper Primary Schools;

(b) in respect of all matters expressly required or allowed by this Act to be prescribed.

11. (1) The Orissa Education (Amendment) Ordinance, 1989 is hereby repealed.
 (2) Notwithstanding anything done or any action taken including notifications issued or rules or orders made under the principal Act, as amended by the said Ordinance it shall be deemed to have been done, taken, issued or made under the principal Act as amended by this Act.

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THE ORISSA APPROPRIATION (No. 3) ACT, 1989

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE AUTHORISATION OF APPROPRIATION OF MONEYS OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND OF THE STATE OF ORISSA TO MEET THE AMOUNTS SPENT ON CERTAIN SERVICES DURING FINANCIAL YEARS ENDING ON THE 31ST DAY OF MARCH OF THE YEARS 1981 TO 1986 IN EXCESS OF THE AMOUNTS GRANTED FOR THOSE SERVICES AND FOR THOSE YEARS

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Orissa in the Fortieth year of the Republic of India as follows :—

Short title

1. This Act may be called the Orissa Appropriation (No. 3) Act, 1989.

Issue of Rs. 814,81,33,607 out of the Consolidated Fund of Orissa for the years ended on 31st March of the years 1981 to 1986.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Orissa, the sums specified in column 4 of the schedule, for the years 1980-81 to 1985-86, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of rupees eight hundred and fourteen crores, eighty-one lakhs, fifty-three thousand and six hundred seven shall be deemed to have been authorised to be paid and applied to meet the amount spent for defraying the charges in respect of the services specified in column 3 of the schedule during the financial years which ended on the 31st day of March of the years 1981 to 1986 in excess of the amounts granted for those services and for those years.

Appropriation.

3. The sums deemed to have been authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Orissa under this Act shall be deemed to have been appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the schedule in relation to each financial year which ended on the 31st day of March, of the years 1981 to 1986.
