

ORISSA ORDINANCE NO. 2 OF 1987

THE ORISSA CONTINGENCY FUND (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1987

[Promulgated by the Governor on the 25th November 1987, first published in an extraordinary issue of the Orissa Gazette, dated the 27th November, 1987]

AN

ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE ORISSA CONTINGENCY FUND ACT, 1967

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Orissa is not in session;

AND WHEREAS, the Governor of Orissa is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action to amend the Orissa Contingency Fund Act, 1967 in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 213 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance in the Thirty-eighth year of the Republic of India:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Orissa Contingency Fund (Amendment) Ordinance, 1987.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. During the period of operation of this Ordinance, the Orissa Contingency Fund Act, 1967 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act) shall have effect subject to the amendment specified in section 3. Orissa Act 18 of 1967.

3. In section 2 of the Principal Act, in sub-section (1), for the words "twenty crores of rupees", the words "seventy crores of rupees" shall be substituted.
