

ORISSA ACT 19 OF 1991

1. [THE REGISTRATION (ORISSA AMENDMENT) ACT, 1991]

[Received the assent of the President on the 2nd August, 1991, first published in an extraordinary issue of the Orissa Gazette, dated the 17th September, 1991]

AN ACT FURTHER TO AMEND THE REGISTRATION ACT, 1908 IN ITS APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF ORISSA

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Orissa in the Forty-second Year of the Republic of India, as follows:—

Short title

1. This Act may be called the Registration (Orissa Amendment) Act, 1991.

Amendment of Section 3

2. In the Registration Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), in section 30, sub-section (2) shall be omitted.

Insertion of new Section 80-A.

3. In the principal Act, after section 80, the following section shall be inserted, namely:—

‘Recovery of deficient registration fee as arrears of land revenue.

80-A. If, on inspection or otherwise, it is found that the fee payable under this Act in relation to any document which is registered has been insufficiently paid, the deficient fee shall, after failure to pay the same on demand within the prescribed period, be recoverable from the person who presented such document as arrears of land revenue”.
