## ORDINANCE

FURTHER TO AMEND THE ORISSA SALES TAX ACT, 1947.

WHEREAS the Legislature of the State of Orissa is not in session;

AND WHEREAS, the Governor of Orissa is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action to amend the Orissa Sales Tax Act, 1947 in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 213 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance in the Forty-sixth Year of the Republic of India:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Orissa Sales Tax (Amendment) Ordinance, 1995.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 27th day of May 1995.

Amendment  
of Section 3.

2. In Section 3 of the Orissa Sales Tax Act, 1947 (hereinafter referred to as the Orissa Act Principal Act), in clause (a) of sub-section (2-e), the words and commas "including surcharge, if any," wherever they occur shall be omitted. 14 of 1947.

5-A.

3. Section 5-A of the principal Act shall be omitted.
