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ORISSA ACT 9 OF 1995

***THE ORISSA APPROPRIATION ACT, 1995**

[Received the assent of the Governor on the 27th July, 1995 first published in an extraordinary issue of the *Orissa Gazette*, dated the 28th July 1995]

AN ACT TO AUTHORISE PAYMENT AND APPROPRIATION OF CERTAIN SUMS FROM AND OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND OF THE STATE OF ORISSA FOR THE SERVICES OF THE FINANCIAL YEAR, 1995-96.

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Orissa in the Forty-sixth Year of the Republic of India, as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Orissa Appropriation Act, 1995.

Issue of

Rs. 7076,70, paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule 50,000 out of the Consolidated Fund of Orissa for the financial year, 1995-96.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Orissa, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate [inclusive of the sums specified in column 3 of the Schedule to the Orissa Appropriation (Vote-on-Account) Act, 1995] to the sum of seven thousand seventy-six crores, seventy lakhs and fifty thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year, 1995-96 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule. Orissa Act 5 of 1995.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Orissa by this Act shall be Appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
