THE ORISSA CONTINGENCY FUND (AMENDMENT)**ORDINANCE, 1977**

[Promulgated by the Governor on the 22nd January 1977, published in an extraordinary issue of the Orissa Gazette, dated the 25th January 1977]

AN**ORDINANCE****TO AMEND THE ORISSA CONTINGENCY FUND ACT, 1967**

WHEREAS the Legislature of the State of Orissa is not in session;

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Orissa is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action to amend the Orissa Contingency Fund Act, 1967 in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 213 of the Constitution, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance in the Twenty-seventh Year of the Republic of India:—

Short title
and commence-
ment.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Orissa Contingency Fund (Amendment) Ordinance, 1977.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. During the period of operation of this Ordinance, the Orissa Contingency Fund Act, 1967 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) shall have effect subject to the amendment specified in section 3.

3. In section 2 of the principal Act, to sub-section (1), the following proviso shall be added, namely:—

“Provided that during the period of operation of the Orissa Contingency Fund (Amendment) Ordinance, 1977, this sub-section shall have effect subject to the modification that for the words “two crores of rupees”, the words “ten crores of rupees” shall be substituted.”
