## REGULATION

TO AMEND THE KHONDMALS LAWS REGULATION, 1936

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the Khondmals Laws Regulation, 1936 in the manner after appearing;

Orissa Regulation 4 of 1936.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 5 of the Fifth Schedule to the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to promulgate the following Regulation made by him in the Seventeenth Year of the Republic of India:—

Short title and commencement.

**1.** (1) This Regulation may be called the Khondmals Laws ( Amendment ) Regulation, 1966.

(2) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by notification, appoint in that behalf.

Amendment of section 3, Orissa Regulation 4 of 1936.

**2.** In section 13 of the Khondmals Laws Regulation, 1936 in sub-section (1) for the entry in column 3 against item I of the table, the following entry shall be substituted, namely:—

Orissa Regulation 4 of 1936.

“Such of the powers of a Magistrate under the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898, as may be conferred by the State Government.”
