AN ACT TO AMEND THE SAMBALPUR LOCAL SELF-GOVERNMENT
ACT, 1939

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sambalpur Local Self-Government Act, 1939, for the purpose hereinafter appearing; Orissa Acts VI of 1939.

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sambalpur Local Self-Government (Amendment) Act, 1947.

(2) It shall come into force on the first day of April 1947. (*)

2. In section 134 of the Sambalpur Local Self-Government Act, 1939, for sub-section (1) the following sub-section shall be substituted, namely:— Orissa Act VI of 1939.

“(1) (a) The District Board shall, in a meeting specially convened for the purpose, impose an additional rate or cess for the purposes of this Part at the rate of $6\frac{1}{4}$ per cent of the *kamiljama* assessed on every Zamindari and *malguzari* village of any estate or *mahal*.

(b) With the previous sanction of the Provincial Government the District Board may, by a resolution passed by a majority of members present at a special meeting convened for the purpose, impose a further rate or cess at a rate not exceeding $3\frac{1}{8}$ per cent of the *kamiljama* on every Zamindari and *malguzari* village of an estate or *mahal*, in addition to the rate or cess imposed under clause (a) of this sub-section:

Provided that the rate or cess levied by the District Board shall not be reduced without the previous sanction of the Provincial Government.

Explanation—For the purposes of this sub-section *kamiljama* assessed on every Zamindari and *malguzari* village of any estate or *mahal* shall be deemed to be a sum equivalent to sixty per cent of the total assets of such village calculated in the manner prescribed for determination of the land revenue payable in respect thereof.”
