AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE WITHDRAWAL OF CERTAIN SUMS FROM AND OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND OF THE STATE OF ORISSA FOR THE SERVICES OF A PART OF THE FINANCIAL YEAR, 1995-96

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Orissa in the Forty sixth Year of the Republic of India, as follows:-

Short title-

1. This Act may be called the Orissa Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act **199**5.

Withdawal Rs, 2086,86. Fund of Orissa for the financial year 1995-96.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Orissa, there may be withdrawn sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting Rs. 2086,86,
21,000 out of the aggregate to the sum of two thousand eighty-six croies, eighty-six lakhs and twenty-one thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in Consolidated course of payment during the financial year 1995-96 in respect of the services specified n column 2 of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Orissa by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
