***THE ORISSA PUBLIC DEMANDS RECOVERY (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1981**

[Received the assent of the President on the 26th August 1981; first published in an extraordinary issue of the Orissa Gazette, dated the 10th September 1981]

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ORISSA PUBLIC DEMANDS RECOVERY ACT, 1962

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Orissa in the Thirty-second Year of the Republic of India, as follows :—

- Short title** 1. This Act may be called the Orissa Public Demands Recovery (Amendment) Act 1981.
- Amendment of section 14.** 2. In section 14 of the Orissa Public Demands Recovery Act, 1962 (hereinafter Orissa Act 1962 referred to as the Principal Act) in the proviso to clause (a), for the words "fifteen of 1963. percentum", the words "eighteen percentum" shall be substituted.
- Amendment of Schedule-I.** 3. In Schedule I to the principal Act, for item (xi), the following item shall be substituted, namely :—
- “(xi) Any money payable to—
- (a) a Government Officer ;
 - (b) any local authority ;
 - (c) The Orissa State Electricity Board constituted under the Electricity 54 of 1948 (Supply) Act, 1948 ;
 - (d) any corporation, public sector undertaking or joint sector undertaking which is owned, controlled or managed by the State Government and notified by them from time to time ;
 - (e) any Improvement Trust or Special Planning Authority constituted under Orissa Act the Orissa Town Planning and Improvement Trust Act, 1956, which is 10 of 1957. notified by the State Government from time to time ;
 - (f) the Orissa State Housing Board constituted under the Orissa Housing Board Act, 1968 ; or Orissa Act 11 of 1969.
 - (g) any Scheduled Bank or Regional Rural Bank on account of any loan advanced by such Bank under a State Sponsored Scheme.

in respect of which the person liable to pay the same has agreed, by a written instrument that it shall be recoverable as a public demand.

Explanation—For the purposes of this item,—

- (a) "Scheduled Bank" means a Bank included in the Second Schedule to the 2 of 1934 Reserve Bank of India Act, 1934 ;
- (b) "Regional Rural Bank" means a Bank established under section 3 of the 21 of 1976 Regional Rural Bank Act, 1976 ;
- (c) "State Sponsored Scheme" means a scheme notified as such by the State Government for financial assistance by a Scheduled Bank or a Regional Rural Bank to small Industries artisans, weavers and self-employed persons in a specified locality of the State."
