THE ORISSA APPROPRIATION (No. 3) ACT, 1955

[Received the assent of the Governor on the 20th November 1955,
first published in an extraordinary issue of the Orissa Gazette
dated the 25th November 1955]

AN ACT TO AUTHORISE PAYMENT AND APPROPRIATION
OF CERTAIN FURTHER SUMS FROM AND OUT OF THE
CONSOLIDATED FUND OF THE STATE OF
ORISSA FOR THE SERVICE OF THE YEAR
ENDING ON THE THIRTY-FIRST
DAY OF MARCH 1956

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of
Orissa in the Sixth Year of the Republic of
India as follows :—

Short title * 1. This Act may be called the Orissa Appropria-
tion (No. 3) Act, 1955.

Issue of Rs. 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of
16,73,23,020 Orissa there may be paid and applied sums not ex-
out of the ceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule
Consolidated amounting in the aggregate to the sum of rupees
Fund of sixteen crores, seventy-three lakhs, twenty-three
Orissa for thousand, and twenty towards defraying the several
the year. charges which will come in course of payment during
1955-56. the year ending on the thirty-first day of March 1956,
in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the
Schedule.

Appropriation. 3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied
from and out of the Consolidated Fund of Orissa by
this Act shall be appropriated for the services and
purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the
year ending on the thirty-first day of March 1956.
