***THE ORISSA MOTOR VEHICLES TAXATION LAWS
(SECOND AMENDMENT) ACT, 1974**

[Received the assent of the Governor on the 2nd January 1975, first published in an extraordinary issue of the Orissa Gazette, dated the 14th January 1975]

AN ACT FURTHER TO AMEND THE BIHAR AND ORISSA MOTOR VEHICLES TAXATION ACT, 1930 AND THE MADRAS MOTOR VEHICLES TAXATION ACT, 1931 IN THEIR APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF ORISSA

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Orissa in the Twenty-fifth Year of the Republic of India, as follows :—

Short title and commencement.

1. (1) This Act may be called the Orissa Motor Vehicles Taxation Laws (Second Amendment) Act, 1974.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October, 1974.

Amendment of Bihar and Orissa Act 2 of 1930 and Madras Act 3 of 1931.

2. In the Second Schedule to the Bihar and Orissa Motor Vehicles Taxation Act, 1930 and in Schedule II to the Madras Motor Vehicles Taxation Act, 1931 as amended by the Orissa Motor Vehicles Taxation Laws (Amendment) Act, 1974 in item 4,—

Bihar and Orissa Act 2 of 1930.
Madras Act 3 of 1931.
Orissa Act 23 of 1974.

(a) for sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (A) (excluding the proviso occurring thereunder), the following sub-paragraph shall be substituted, namely :—

“(ii) for every standing passenger 100”

(b) for sub-paragraphs (i) and (ii) of paragraph (B), the following sub-paragraphs shall be substituted, namely :—

“(i) for seating not more than six persons for every person which the vehicle is permitted to carry excluding the driver. 120

(ii) for seating more than six persons, for every person which the vehicle is permitted to carry excluding the driver and the conductor. 144”

Repealed

3. The Orissa Motor Vehicles Taxation Laws (Amendment) Ordinance, 1974, is hereby repealed.
