

ORISSA ACT V OF 1949.
THE ORISSA STAMP (TEMPORARY AMENDMENT)
ACT, 1949.

[Received the assent of the Governor on the 22nd May 1949, first
published in an extraordinary issue of the Orissa Gazette
dated the 26th May 1949]

AN ACT FURTHER TO AMEND THE INDIAN STAMP ACT, 1899,
TEMPORARILY IN ITS APPLICATION TO THE
PROVINCE OF ORISSA.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Indian Stamp II of 1899 Act, 1899, temporarily in its application to the Province of Orissa in the manner hereinafter appearing ;

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

Short title
and com-
mencement,

1. (1) This Act may be called the Orissa Stamp (Temporary Amendment) Act, 1949.

(2) It shall come into force at once.*

(3) It shall remain in force for the limited period of one year

2. In Schedule I-A to the Indian Stamp Act, 1899, II of 1899, for the words "Seven hundred and fifty rupees," in column 2 against clause (a) of item No. 30 the words "Five hundred rupees" shall be substituted.
