

THE DEOGARH MUNICIPAL COUNCIL (POSTPONEMENT OF ELECTIONS) ORDINANCE, 1979

[Promulgated by the Governor on the 9th January 1979, published in an extraordinary issue of the Orissa Gazette, dated the 9th January 1979]

AN

ORDINANCE

TO PROVIDE FOR THE POSTPONEMENT OF ELECTIONS TO THE DEOGARH MUNICIPAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS the Legislature of the State of Orissa is not in session ;

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Orissa is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action to provide for the postponement of elections to the Deogarh Municipal Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 213 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance in the Twenty-ninth Year of the Republic of India:—

Short title and comment.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Deogarh Municipal Council (Postponement of Elections) Ordinance, 1979.

Postponement of Election.

(2) It shall come into force at once.
2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Orissa Municipal Councils (Postponement of Elections) Ordinance, 1978—

Orissa Ordinance No. 8 of 1978,

(a) the proceedings for holding elections for the reconstitution of the municipal council of the Deogarh Municipality in the District of Sambalpur as constituted under the Orissa Municipal Act, 1950, are hereby postponed from the stage of presentation of nomination papers; Orissa Act 23 of 1950.

(b) the stages of the proceedings which are so postponed shall be carried out from such date as the State Government may fix, so, however, that the aforesaid elections shall be completed by a date not later than the 1st day of August, 1979; and

(c) upon fixation of a date under clause (b), the election officer shall issue fresh notice calling for nominations and shall take all further action in accordance with the provisions of the said Act.

ORDINANCE

TO PROVIDE FOR THE POSTPONEMENT OF ELECTIONS TO THE
DEGGAR MUNICIPAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS the Legislature of the State of Orissa is not in

session and whereas the Government of Orissa is satisfied that certain
circumstances exist which render it necessary for the Government to
postpone the elections to the Deggar Municipal Council

in accordance with the provisions of the Government of Orissa Act, 1950
and whereas the Government is pleased to make and promulgate the following
Ordinance in exercise of the powers conferred by

Section 177 of the Government of Orissa Act, 1950

That this Ordinance may be called the Deggar Municipal
Council (Postponement of Elections) Ordinance, 1970—

(1) It shall come into force at once.
(2) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Government of Orissa Act, 1950, the elections to the Deggar Municipal Council shall be postponed from the date specified in the Government of Orissa Act, 1950 to the date specified in the Government of Orissa Act, 1970.

(3) The provisions for holding elections for the reconstruction of the municipal council of the Deggar Municipality in the District of Sambalpur as contained under the Government of Orissa Act, 1950 are hereby postponed from the date specified in the Government of Orissa Act, 1950 to the date specified in the Government of Orissa Act, 1970.

(4) The dates of the proceedings which are so postponed shall be carried out from such date as the State Government may, in so far as may be, complete by a date not later than the date specified in the Government of Orissa Act, 1970.

(5) The provisions of the Government of Orissa Act, 1950 shall apply to the elections to the Deggar Municipal Council as if they had been made on the date specified in the Government of Orissa Act, 1970.
