ORDINANCE

TO AMEND SHRI JAGANNATH TEMPLE (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1968

WHEREAS the Legislature of the State of Orissa is not in session;

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Orissa is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action to amend Shri Jagannath Temple (Amendment) Act, 1968 in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 213 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance in the Twentieth Year of the Republic of India :—

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be called Shri Jagannath Temple (Amendment) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1969.

2. In section 18 of Shri Jagannath Temple (Amendment) Act, 1968—

- (a) for the words "on the expiry of a period of three months" the words "on the expiry of a period of one year" shall be and shall be deemed always to have been substituted;
- (b) after the existing proviso the following new proviso shall be added, namely :—

"Provided further that if at any time prior to the expiry of the period of one year or, as the case may be, the extended period as aforesaid, the Committee is reconstituted in accordance with the principal Act as amended by this Act, the said members shall cease to hold office with effect from the date of notification of the appointment or nomination of the members of the Committee as so reconstituted".
