ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE ORISSA LAND REFORMS ACT, 1960

WHEREAS the Legislature of the State of Orissa is not in session;

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Orissa is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action to amend the Orissa Land Reforms Act, 1960 in the manner hereinafter appearing ; Orissa Act
16 of 1960.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 213 of the Constitution, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance in the Seventeenth Year of the Republic of India :—

Short title
and commen-
cement.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Orissa Land Reforms (Second Amendment) Ordinance, 1966.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment
of section

2. For section 66 of the Orissa Land Reforms Act, 1960, the following section shall be substituted, Orissa Act
16 of 1960.
namely :—

Fees of legal
practitioners
not to form
part of costs.

“66. Fees of legal practitioners appearing in any proceedings under this Act shall not form part of the costs in any such proceedings.”

Savings

3. Anything done or any action taken under the Orissa Land Reforms (Amendment) Ordinance, 1966, shall be deemed to have been done or taken under this Ordinance as if this Ordinance were in force on the day on which such thing was done or action was taken. Orissa
