AN
ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE ORISSA MUNICIPAL ACT, 1950

WHEREAS the Legislature of the State of Orissa is not in session ;

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Orissa is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action to amend the Orissa Municipal Act, 1950, in the manner hereinafter appearing ;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 213 of the Constitution, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :—

Short title
and com-
mencement.

*1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Orissa Municipal (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In section 131 of the Orissa Municipal Act, 1950 after clause (k) of sub-section (1) the following new clause shall be inserted, namely :—

“(kk) an octroi on goods brought within the limits of a municipality for consumption, use or sale therein ;”

Validation
of existing
octroi tax.

3. Any order made by a municipality in any part of the State of Orissa directing the imposition or collection of any octroi tax or any action taken thereunder prior to the commencement of this Ordinance shall be deemed to have been validly made or taken under the provisions of section 131 of the Orissa Municipal Act 1950, as amended by this Ordinance.
