(AMENDMENT) ACT, 1967

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ORISSA OFFICES OF VILLAGE POLICE (ABOLITION) ACT, 1964

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Orissa in the Eighteenth Year of the Republic of India, as follows:—

***1.** This Act may be called the Orissa Offices of Village Police (Abolition) (Amendment) Act, 1967.

2. In section 4 of the Orissa Offices of Village Police (Abolition) Act, 1964 after sub-section (6) the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:—

“Provided that in cases where any Village Police Officer has already been settled with one acre of cultivable land with rights of occupancy therein prior to the appointed date solely in consideration of the impending abolition of his office, the settlement so made shall, for all purposes, be deemed to be settlement of land made under this sub-section.”
