AN ACT TO AMEND THE ORISSA FIREWORKS AND LOUDSPEAKERS (REGULATION) ACT, 1958

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Orissa in the
Thirtieth Year of the Republic of India, as follows:—

Short title 1. This Act may be called the Orissa Fireworks and Loudspeakers (Regulation) Amendment Act, 1979.

Insertion of
New section
3-A. 2. After section 3 of the Orissa Fireworks and Loudspeakers (Regulation) Act, 1958 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act),
the following new section shall be inserted, namely:— Orissa Act
90 of 1958

Power to
prohibit
display of
explosive
fire works
and use and
play of loud-
speakers. “3-A. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the District Magistrate or any other person authorised by the State Government in that behalf may, on being satisfied that in his opinion it is necessary in the public interest so to do, by an order in writing recording reasons therefor, prohibit the display of any explosive fireworks or the use and play of loudspeakers, in any place and at any time.”

Amendment
of section 5. 3. In section 5 of the principal Act,—
(a) for the words “one month”, the words “six months” shall be substituted; and
(b) for the words “two hundred rupees”, the words “five hundred rupees” shall be substituted.

Amendment
of section 6. 4. For section 6 of the principal Act (excluding the proviso thereto), the following section shall be substituted, namely:—
“6. No Magistrate shall take cognizance of any offence under this Act except upon a report in writing made in that behalf by a Police Officer or on a complaint filed before him by any aggrieved person.”
