## REGULATION

TO REPEAL CERTAIN LAWS IN AND TO EXTEND CERTAIN OTHERS  
TO THE DISTRICT OF KORAPUT AND IN GANJAM AGENCY  
EXCLUDING THE KHONDMAIS, THE CHOKPAD  
KHANDAM AND THE PANDAKHOL MUTTHA  
OF SURUDA MULIAHS

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to repeal certain laws in and to extend certain others to the district of Koraput and the Ganjam Agency excluding the Khondmalls, the Chokpad Khandam and the Pandakhhol Muttha of Suruda Muliahs, which are Scheduled Areas of the State of Orissa;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 5 read with sub-paragraph (3) thereof, of the Fifth Schedule to the Constitution, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to promulgate the following Regulation made by him :—

Short title

1. (1) This Regulation may be called the Koraput and Ganjam Agency Repealing and Extension of Laws Regulation, 1951.

(2) It shall come into force on such date or dates as the State Government may by notification from time to time appoint.

Repeals and  
Savings.

2. The Orissa Agency Rules and the Ganjam Vizagapatam Act, 1839, shall stand repealed in and the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 and the Bengal, Agra and Assam Civil Courts Act, 1887, notwithstanding anything contained in Orissa Laws Regulation, 1936, shall extend to the district of Koraput and the Ganjam Agency excluding the areas specified in the preamble :

Provided that the repeal of the Orissa Agency Rules and the Ganjam Vizagapatam Act, 1839, by this Act shall not affect-  
XXIV of 1839.

(a) the previous operation of such laws so repealed or the validity, invalidity, effect or consequence of anything already done or suffered thereunder; or

(b) any right, title, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued or incurred under the said laws ; or

(c) any investigation, legal proceeding or remedy in respect of such right, title, privilege, obligation or liability as aforesaid ; or

(d) any release of or discharge from any debt, penalty, obligation, liability, claim or demand ; or

(e) any indemnity granted or the proof of any past act or thing ;

and any such investigation, legal proceeding or remedy may be instituted, continued or enforced as if this Act had not been passed.
