

ORISSA ORDINANCE No. 9 OF 1978

THE KHARIAR ROAD NOTIFIED AREA COUNCIL (POSTPONEMENT OF ELECTIONS) ORDINANCE, 1978

Promulgated by the Governor on the 25th October 1978 published in an extraordinary issue of the Orissa Gazette, dated the 25th October 1978

AN

ORDINANCE

TO PROVIDE FOR POSTPONEMENT OF ELECTIONS TO
THE KHARIAR ROAD NOTIFIED AREA COUNCIL
AND FOR MATTERS INCIDENTAL THERETO

WHEREAS the Legislature of the State of Orissa is not in session;

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Orissa is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action to provide for the postponement of the elections to the Khariar Road Notified Area Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 213 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance in the Twenty-ninth Year of the Republic of India:—

Short title and commencement.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Khariar Road Notified Area Council (Postponement of Elections) Ordinance, 1978.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Definition

2. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires,—

(a) "Municipal Act" means the Orissa Municipal Act, 1950;

Orissa Act
23 of 1950.

(b) words and expressions used in this Ordinance, but not defined herein, shall have the same meaning as assigned to them respectively, under the Municipal Act.

Postponement of elections.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Municipal Act or in any rules or orders made or issued thereunder, all proceedings and actions taken in furtherance of holding elections for the reconstitution of the Khariar Road Notified Area Council constituted under the said Act are hereby cancelled, and elections for such reconstitution shall be held in accordance with the provisions of that Act on such date, not being later than the 1st day of February 1979, as may be fixed by the State Government.
