

***THE REGISTRATION (ORISSA AMENDMENT) ACT, 1975**

[Received the assent of the President on the 5th April 1976, first published in an extraordinary issue of the Orissa Gazette, dated the 13th April 1976]

AN ACT TO AMEND THE REGISTRATION ACT, 1908 IN ITS APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF ORISSA

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Orissa in the Twenty-sixth Year of the Republic of India, as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Registration (Orissa Short title Amendment) Act, 1975.

16 of 1908 2. In section 69 of the Registration Act, 1908, in Amendment of section 69. sub-section (1), after clause (b), the following new clause shall be inserted, namely:—

“(bb) providing for the grant of licences to document writers, the revocation of such licences, the terms and conditions subject to which and the authority by whom such licences shall be granted, the exemption of any class of document writers from the licensing provisions and the conditions subject to which such exemption shall be granted and generally for all purposes connected with the writing of documents to be presented for registration”.
