

ODISHA ACT 1 OF 1941

THE ODISHA TENANCY (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1941

(24th January 1941)

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ODISHA TENANCY ACT, 1913.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Orissa Tenancy Act, 1913, in the manner hereinafter appearing; B. and O. Act II of 1913.

The Governor of Orissa in exercise of the legislative powers assumed to himself by Proclamation, dated the 6th November, 1939, under section 93 of the Government of India Act, 1935, hereby enacts as follows:—

Short title and commencement.

1. (1) This Act may be called the Orissa Tenancy (Amendment) Act, 1941.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment of section 31 of Bihar and Orissa Act II of 1913.

2. In section 31 of the Orissa Tenancy Act, 1913, after sub-section (6) the following sub-section shall be inserted, B. and O. Act II of 1913. namely:—

“(6A). Notwithstanding anything contained in the preceding provisions of this section, in any case of transfer of an occupancy holding or a portion or share thereof in a Government estate, of which rent is payable direct to Government, the notices referred to in sub-sections (2) to (6) shall not be required to be accompanied by any fee for the service of such notices on the landlord, and need not be served by the Collector on the Provincial Government as landlord.”
