**AN  
ORDINANCE**

TO AMEND THE ORISSA CONTINGENCY FUND ACT, 1950

**WHEREAS** the Legislature of the State of Orissa is not in session ;

**AND WHEREAS** the Governor of Orissa is satisfied that it is expedient to amend the Orissa Contingency Fund Act, 1950 and that the circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action in the manner hereinafter appearing ; Orissa Act  
XXV of  
1950.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 213 of the Constitution, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance : --

Short title  
and commencement.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Orissa Contingency Fund ( Amendment ) Ordinance, 1954.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In section 4 of the Orissa Contingency Fund Act, 1950, for the words "a sum of thirty-five lakhs of rupees" the words "a sum of one crore of rupees" shall be substituted. Orissa Act
