ORDINANCE

FURTHER TO AMEND THE ORISSA SALES TAX ACT, 1947.

WHEREAS the Legislature of the State of Orissa is not in session ;

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Orissa is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action to amend the Orissa Sales Tax Act, 1947 in the manner hereinafter appearing ;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (i) of Article 213 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance in the Forty-ninth Year of the Republic of India:—

Short title
and

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Orissa Sales Tax (Amendment) Ordinance, 1998.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

section 3

2. In the Orissa Sales Tax Act, 1947, in section 3,—

- (i) in sub-section (2), for the words "four members", the words "six members" shall be substituted; and
- (ii) in sub-section (2-a), for the words "Two members", "other two members" and "upgraded supertime scale", the words "Three members", "other three members" and "superior administrative grade" shall respectively be substituted.
