REGULATION

TO AMEND THE KHONDMAIS LAWS REGULATION, 1936

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Khondma's Law Regulation, 1936, for the purpose hereinafter appearing; Orissa Regulation IV of 1936.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governor of Orissa, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 92 of the Government of India Act, 1935, is pleased to make the following Regulation:—

Short title and commencement.

1. (1) This Regulation may be called the Khondma's Laws (Amendment) Regulation, 1946.

Amendment of the Schedule to Orissa Regulation IV of 1936.

2. It shall come into force at once.

(2) In Part II of the Schedule to the Khondma's Laws Regulation, 1936, the following amendments shall be made, namely:— Orissa Regulation IV of 1936.

(a) The entry "1870 VII The Court Fees Act, 1870. Ditto." shall be inserted immediately below the entry "1869 IV The Indian Divorce Act. Ditto."

(b) The entry "1899 II The Indian Stamp Act, 1899. Ditto." shall be inserted immediately below the entry "1898 VI The Indian Post Office Act, 1898. Ditto."
