AN

ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE ORISSA CONTINGENCY FUND ACT, 1950

WHEREAS the Legislature of the State of Orissa is not in session ;

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Orissa is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action to amend the Orissa Contingency Fund Act, 1950 in the manner hereinafter appearing ;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 213 of the Constitution, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance in the Seventeenth Year of the Republic of India.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Orissa Contingency Fund (Amendment) Ordinance, 1966.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. For section 4-A of the Orissa Contingency Fund Act, 1950, the following section shall be substituted, namely :—

of the State
and credit
thereof to the

Fund.

“4-A. The State Government shall, on the commencement of the Orissa Contingency Fund (Amendment) Ordinance, 1966, withdraw a further sum of rupees eight crores and sixty-five lakhs out of the Consolidated Fund of the State and place it to the credit of the Fund.”
