## AN ACT TO AMEND THE ORISSA MILITARY POLICE ACT, 1946

**BE** it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Orissa in the Thirty-first Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

Short title  
and  
commence-  
ment.

1. (1) This Act may be called the Orissa Military Police (Amendment) Act, 1980.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment  
of long title.

2. In the Orissa Military Police Act, 1946 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), in the long title, for the words "Military Police" the words "Special Armed Police" shall be substituted. Orissa Act 7 of 1946.

Amendment  
of section 1.

3. In section 1 of the Principal Act, in sub-section (1), for the words "Military Police", the words "Special Armed Police" shall be substituted.

General  
Amendment.

4. In sections 2 to 13 and in the Schedule to the Principal Act, for the words "Military Police", wherever they occur, the words "Special Armed Police" shall be substituted.

Construction  
of references.

5. References in any Act, rule, notification or order to the Orissa Military Police Act, 1946 shall, on the commencement of this Act, be construed as references to the Orissa Special Armed Police Act, 1946. Orissa Act 7 of 1946.

Savings.

6. (1) The alteration of the short title of the Orissa Military Police Act, 1946 shall not affect the previous operation of the Orissa Military Police Act, 1946. Orissa Act 7 of 1946.

(2) The Military Police Officers who are appointed and are continuing in office on the date of commencement of this Act, shall, save as otherwise provided in the principal Act, be deemed to have been appointed as Special Armed Police Officers under the principal Act as amended by this Act.
