(Received the assent of the Governor on the 20th April 1977, first published in an extraordinary issue of the Orissa Gazette, dated the 25th April 1977.)

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ORISSA BHOODAN AND GRAMDAN
ACT, 1970

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Orissa in the Twenty-eighth Year of the Republic of India, as follows:—

Short title
and com-
mencement.

1. (1) This Act may be called the Orissa Bhoodan and Gramdan (Amendment) Act, 1977.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 9th day of March, 1977.

Amendment
of section 4.

2. In section 4 of the Orissa Bhoodan and Gramdan Act, 1970 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) for sub-section (1) including its proviso the following sub-section shall be substituted, namely:—

“(1) The Samiti shall consist of a Chairman, a Vice-Chairman and nine other members to be appointed by State Government.”

Amendment
of section 5.

3. To section 5 of the principal Act, the following proviso shall be added, namely:—

“Provided that the State Government, whenever they deem it expedient so to do may, by notification, extend from time to time, the aforesaid term of office, so, however, that the total extension does not in the aggregate exceed one year.”

Repeal and
savings.

4. (1) The Orissa Bhoodan and Gramdan (Amendment) Ordinance, 1977, is hereby repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, any notification issued, anything done or any action taken under the principal Act as amended by the said Ordinance, shall be deemed to have been issued, done or taken under the principal Act as amended by this Act.
