ACT

TO AUTHORISE PAYMENT AND APPROPRIATION OF CERTAIN FURTHER  
SUMS FROM AND OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND OF THE STATE OF  
ODISHA FOR CERTAIN SERVICES AND PURPOSES  
DURING THE FINANCIAL YEAR, 2016-2017.

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Odisha in the Sixty-seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Odisha Appropriation (No.2) Act, 2016.

Issue of  
Rs.6014,06,08,000 out of  
the Consolidated Fund of  
the State of Odisha for the  
financial year, 2016-2017.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Odisha there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Six thousand fourteen crores, six lakhs eight thousand rupees towards defraying several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 2016-2017 in respect of the services and purposes specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorized to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Odisha by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the financial year 2016-2017.
