AN ACT TO AMEND THE ORISSA CO-OPERATIVE SOCIETIES ACT, 1962

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Orissa in the
Twenty-seventh Year of the Republic of India, as follows :—

Short title

1. This Act may be called the Orissa Co-operative Societies
(Amendment) Act, 1976.

Amend-

28-A.

2. In section 28-A of the Orissa Co-operative Societies Act, 1962 ^{Orissa Act 2 of 1963.}
(hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), for sub-section (4), the
following sub-section shall be substituted, namely :—

“(4) Upon receipt of the intimation as aforesaid or upon his
own information as to the aforesaid date, the election officer
shall forthwith—

(a) fix the date of the general meeting of the society for
holding the election and publish such date in the pres-
cribed manner :

Provided that in no case the period intervening between the
date of such publication and the date of the election
meeting so fixed shall be less than two months;

(b) direct the Secretary or the Executive Officer of the Society
to prepare the forms of notice for the meeting and
deliver them to him on or before a date to be specified in
that direction.”

Insertion of
section 35-A.

3. After section 35 of the principal Act, the following new section
shall be inserted, namely :—

Deduction
of dues of a
Society of a
reciprocating
State.

“35-A. Where a requisition in writing from any Society registered
or deemed to be registered in any reciprocating State in
respect of a member of that Society, who has executed an agreement
of the nature described in sub-section (1) of section 35 in
favour of that Society and who for the time being is employed
in the State of Orissa, is received by his employer, the
requisition shall be acted upon as if it had been made
by a Society registered under this Act in the same manner as is
provided in the said section.

Explanation—For the purposes of this section ‘reciprocating State’
means any State which the State Government may, by notification,
declare to be a reciprocating State.”
