

ORISSA ACT 36 OF 1962

THE ORISSA HOMEOPATHIC (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1962

[Received the assent of the President on the 18th Decembet 1962,
first published in an extraordinary issue of the Orissa Gazette,
dated the 31st December 1962]

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ORISSA HOMEOPATHIC ACT, 1956

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Orissa in the Thirteenth Year of the Republic of India, as follows:—

Short title 1. This Act may be called the Orissa Homeopathic (Amendment) Act, 1962.

Amendment of section 21, Orissa Act 8 of 1957. 2. In section 21 of the Orissa Homeopathic Act, 1956 after sub-section (3), the following new sub-section shall be inserted, namely:—

“(3-a) No person shall, unless he has attained the age of majority by the date of application referred to in sub-section (4), be enrolled either as a ‘registered Homeopathic Practitioner’ or as a ‘listed Homeopathic Practitioner’.”
