**THE BOLANGIR MUNICIPAL COUNCIL
(VALIDATION OF ELECTION) ORDINANCE, 1979**

AN

ORDINANCE

TO VALIDATE THE ELECTIONS IN RESPECT OF WARD No. 1 OF
THE BALANGIR MUNICIPALITY

WAEREAS the Legislature of the State of Orissa is not in
session ;

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Orissa is satisfied that
circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take
immediate action to validate the elections held in respect of Ward
No. 1 of Balangir Municipality in the manner hereinafter
appearing ;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by
clause (1) of Article 213 of the Constitution of India, the Governor
of Orissa is pleased to make and promulgate the following
Ordinance in the Thirtieth year of the Republic of India :—

Short title,
and com-
mencement.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Balangir Municipal
Council (Validation of Election) Ordinance, 1979.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Validation of
election.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Orissa
Municipal Act, 1950 and the Orissa Municipal Councils
(Postponement of Elections) Ordinance, 1978, the polling of votes
held on the 12th day of February, 1979 in Booth No. 1 of Ward No. 1
of the Balangir Municipality for the election of the Chairman of the
said Municipality and of the Councillor of the said ward and the
publication of the names of the elected Chairman and Councillors of
that Municipality made by the District Magistrate, Balangir on the
19th day of February, 1979 shall be deemed to have been validly
held and made ; and no such election or publication shall be
questioned in any Court of law merely on the ground that the polling
of votes and the publication of names as aforesaid were done on a
date subsequent to the 1st day of February, 1979.
