

ORISSA ORDINANCE No. 1 OF 1966

**SHRI JAGANNATH TEMPLE (AMENDMENT)
ORDINANCE, 1966**

[Promulgated by the Governor on the 5th February 1966, published in an extraordinary issue of the Orissa Gazette, dated the 7th February 1966.]

AN

ORDINANCE

TO AMEND SHRI JAGANNATH TEMPLE ACT, 1954

WHEREAS the Legislature of the State of Orissa is not in session ;

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Orissa is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action to amend Shri Jagannath Temple Act, 1954 in the manner hereinafter appearing ;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 213 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance in the Seventeenth Year of the Republic of India :—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called Shri Jagannath Temple (Amendment) Ordinance, 1966.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 8th day of November 1965.

2. In section 11 of Shri Jagannath Temple Act, 1954 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) sub-section (4) shall be omitted.

3. In section 14 of the principal Act, in sub-section (2) for the words "and except the Administrator no other member of the Committee" the words "no member of the Committee" shall be substituted.

Amendment of section 19, Orissa Act 11 of 1955.

4. For section 19 of the principal Act, the following section shall be substituted, namely :—

Appointment of Administrator and officers to assist him.

“19. (1) There shall be an Administrator for the Temple who shall be appointed by the State Government from amongst persons in their active service and professing Hindu religion.

(2) The State Government may also appoint one or more officers from amongst persons in their active service and professing Hindu religion to assist the Administrator and the officers so appointed shall, subject to the control of the Administrator, perform such duties as he may, from time to time, assign.”

Omission of section 20, Orissa Act 11 of 1955.

5. Section 20 of the principal Act shall be omitted.

Amendment of section 32, Orissa Act 11 of 1955.

6. In section 32 of the principal Act in sub-section (2) clause (g) shall be omitted.
