## TO AMEND THE ORISSA ADDITIONAL SALE TAX ACT 1975

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Orissa is not in session;

AND WHEREAS, the Governor of Orissa is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action to amend the Orissa Additional Sales Tax Act, 1975 in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 213 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance in the Thirty-fourth Year of the Republic of India:—

Short title  
and commencement.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Orissa Additional Sales Tax (Second Amendment) Ordinance, 1983.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment  
of section 3

2. In section 3 of the Orissa Additional Sales Tax Act, 1975, to sub-section (1) the following proviso shall be and shall be deemed to have been added with effect from the 1st day of April 1979, namely:—

Orissa Act,  
24 of 1975.

"Provided that no additional sales tax as aforesaid shall be payable on that part of the gross turnover which relates to sale and purchase of declared goods".
